The CCA Master's degree is a high-level university program designed to train accounting and auditing professionals. The courses are taught in English by both academics and professionals , who are recognized specialists in their field. It combines theoretical knowledge with practical accounting and auditing skills , including legal and managerial concepts

Level of study

Master's degree (Bac +5); institution-awarded diploma at Level 7 (ex-level I)

Credits

30 ECTS per semester, 120 ECTS in total

Admission Requirements

M1:

- ◆ CCA Bachelor's degree, in French or English.
- ◆ Intec's DGC / State examination's DGC.
- ◆ General bachelor's degree in financial accounting, management accounting, or finance (Accounting and tax knowledge will be assessed).
- ◆ Possible access through VAPP (Validation of Professional and Personal Experience)

M2:

- ◆ Having passed Intec's CCA M1 (with an average grade $\geq 10/20$ in each semester and no UE grade $< 6/20$) except for students admitted through VAPP or VES.
- ◆ Hold a comparable Master's degree, subject to selection.

Program Duration

This program is completed over 2 years of study.

Programme objectives

Intec's CCA Master's training program is in line with the DSGC program, and all aspects of the program will be covered , in order to best prepare our students for the 2 UE of the DSGC required to enter the public accounting internship (UE 1 : Management Law & UE 4: Accounting and auditing).

16-week internship is required for students who are not part of an apprenticeship course or continuing education.

Graduation requirements

- ◆ No written examination mark < 6/20.
- ◆ No final average mark (written examinations + continuous assessment) < 6/20.
- ◆ An average $\geq 10/20$ in each of the two semesters comprising the academic year.

Important: semesters and academic years are not compensable. Only grades obtained in Intec-organized exams are considered.

In the event of **resits**:

For a validated semester, all subjects are considered validated.

For a non-validated semester, only final average marks $\geq 10/20$, with a final examination mark $\geq 6/20$, may be carried forward.

Admission to the M2 requires the prior and full completion of the M1 CCA, except for students admitted through VAPP or VES.

Except for students entering directly into M2, obtaining the CCA Master's degree requires the full validation of both M1 and M2.
